# Travel

## Travel to and around London

### From Abroad

Travelling to London from outside the UK? Here's everything you need to know to make your journey seamless.

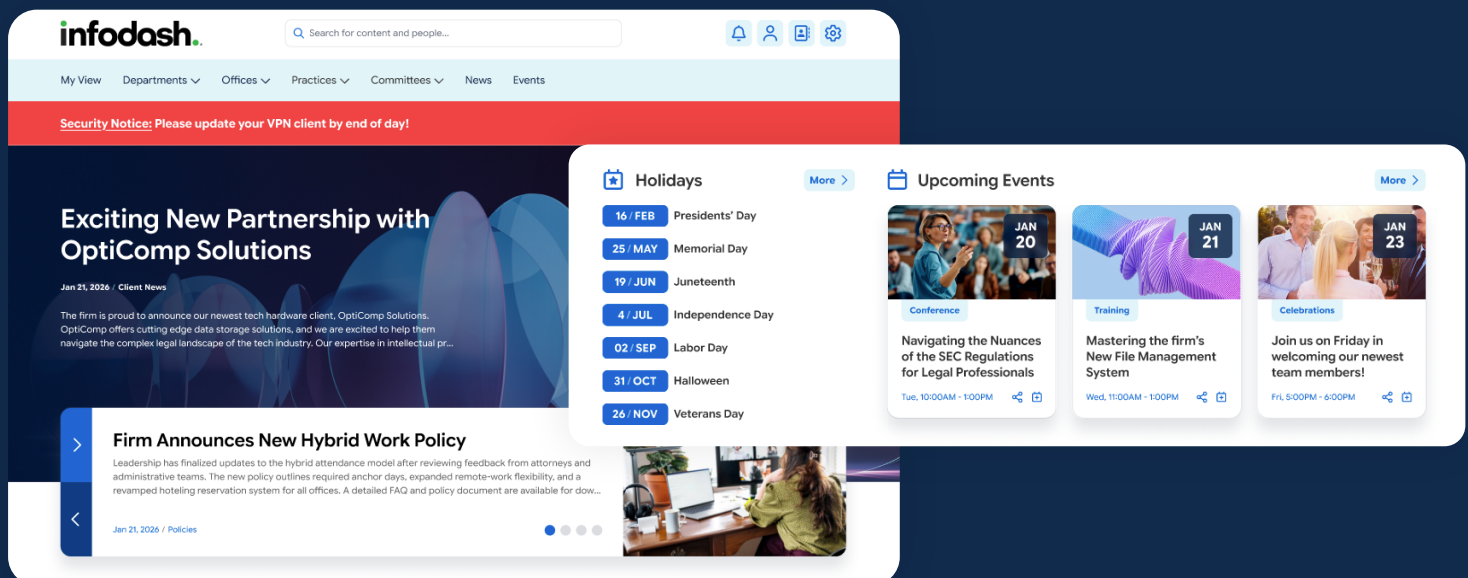
### Travelling by Air

London is served by several major airports, all with good rail, underground, or coach/ bus links directly into central London. The main airports are:

- London Heathrow (LHR)
- London Gatwick (LGW)
- London City Airport (LCY)
- London Stansted (STN)
- London Luton (LTN)
- London Southend (SEN)

Each airport offers fast and regular transport services into the city, along with easy access to taxis and public transport networks.

Transfer times into central London typically range from 30 to 90 minutes, depending on your arrival airport and chosen mode of transport.



# Travel

---

## From the UK

London is easily accessible by train from other parts of the UK, with a wide network of rail services connecting major cities directly to London's central stations.

### Travelling by Train

London is served by several major airports, all with good rail, underground, or coach/ bus links directly into central London. The main airports are:

- From Birmingham, Manchester, or Leeds: Direct trains run regularly to London Euston Station, with journey times typically ranging from 1.5 to 2.5 hours.
- From Liverpool: Trains from Liverpool Lime Street to London Euston take approximately 2 hours.
- From Edinburgh or Glasgow: You can catch a direct service from either city to London King's Cross Station, with journey times around 4.5 to 5 hours.
- Once in Central London, you can easily transfer to the Underground, buses, or taxis to reach the InterContinental London – The O2, the venue for LegalTechTalk.

For detailed schedules and tickets, check the [National Rail website](#) or the train operating companies for your route.

Please be aware that train services can sometimes experience delays or disruptions due to strikes or other unforeseen circumstances. We recommend checking your train service in advance and allowing extra travel time to ensure you arrive without stress.

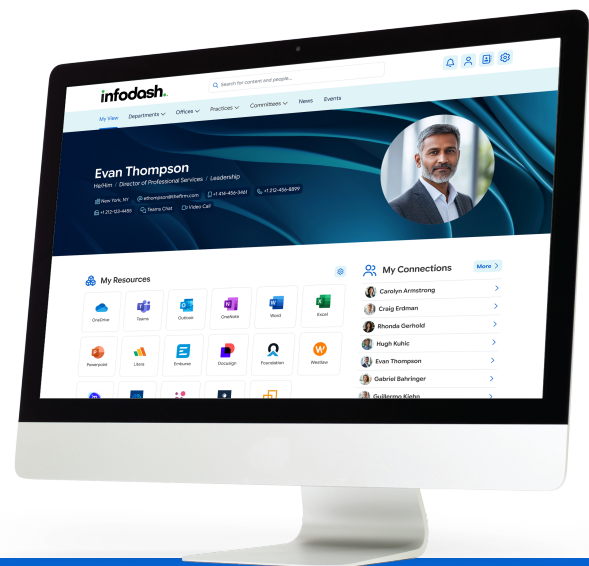

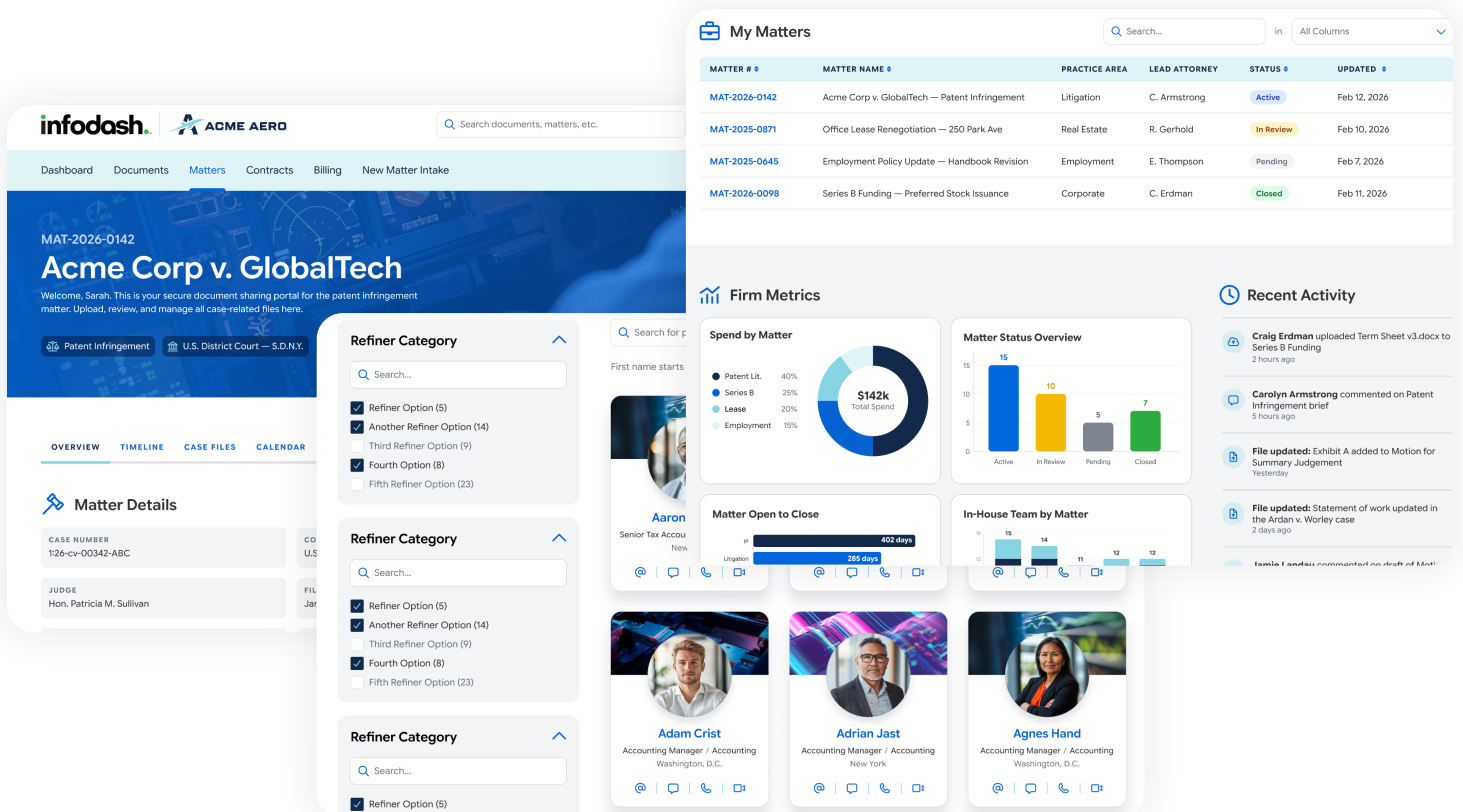

# Getting Around London

---

## Public Transport

- **Underground (Tube):** The London Underground is the fastest way to get around. The venue is easily accessible via the Jubilee Line to North Greenwich station.
- **Buses and DLR (metro):** London's extensive bus network and Docklands Light Railway (DLR)/ metro system offer alternative routes depending on your starting point.

## Tickets & Payments

- **Contactless and Oyster:** You can pay for travel using a contactless debit/credit card, mobile payment (such as Apple Pay or Google Pay), or an Oyster card.
- There is no need to buy a paper ticket – simply tap in and out at the barriers.

## Taxis & Ride-Sharing

- London taxis ("Black Cabs") are widely available and can be hailed on the street.
- Ride-sharing services such as Uber, Bolt, and Free Now operate across London.

## Walking

- Many parts of central London are easily walkable, and walking is often the quickest way to explore nearby sights.

# Who owns the digital workplace?

Ownership in a Big Law digital workplace is not a single-team decision. It is a layered model. Here is how it works and who does what.

Across nearly every Big Law firm we work with, ownership follows the same pattern. IT owns the infrastructure. Knowledge Management owns the experience. Practice groups own their content. Compliance owns the guardrails. The model holds because each group operates within a clearly defined domain, without needing to negotiate every decision with the others.

**The complexity starts where the layers overlap.** A small number of objects, the attorney directory most prominently, draw on data and decisions from multiple teams simultaneously. These shared objects are where ownership disputes concentrate, where launches stall, and where governance needs the most deliberate design. **Knowing where clean ownership ends and shared ownership begins is the difference between a digital workplace that sustains itself and one that quietly degrades.**

## The four-layer ownership model



## The shared objects problem

Three objects sit across all layers simultaneously: the attorney directory, search taxonomy, and DMS integrations. Because no single layer owns them, they become the most contested parts of any launch.

Each needs a named lead and an agreed conflict process. **Committee ownership is not ownership. Resolve these before launch, not after.**

### Two patterns stand out.

- 01

**KM and IT alignment is the highest-leverage governance decision.**  
 KM owns what attorneys experience. IT owns the environment it runs on. Misalignment between them is the most common and most preventable source of failure.
- 02

**The attorney directory is the only row where four teams share responsibility simultaneously.**  
 It needs its own governance conversation before anything else is finalized.

Analytics has been separated into two rows intentionally. Intranet analytics covers adoption, search performance, and content health, all KM capabilities. Financial and BI dashboards surfaced on the intranet are a Finance capability. They have different owners, different data sources, and different governance requirements.

### The structure is consistent.

The execution is where firms diverge.

The firms that launch and sustain effective digital workplaces are not the ones with the largest teams or the most sophisticated technology. They are the ones that defined ownership clearly before anything was built, treated the shared objects as governance problems rather than IT problems, and aligned KM and IT on the same side of the table before the first decision was made.

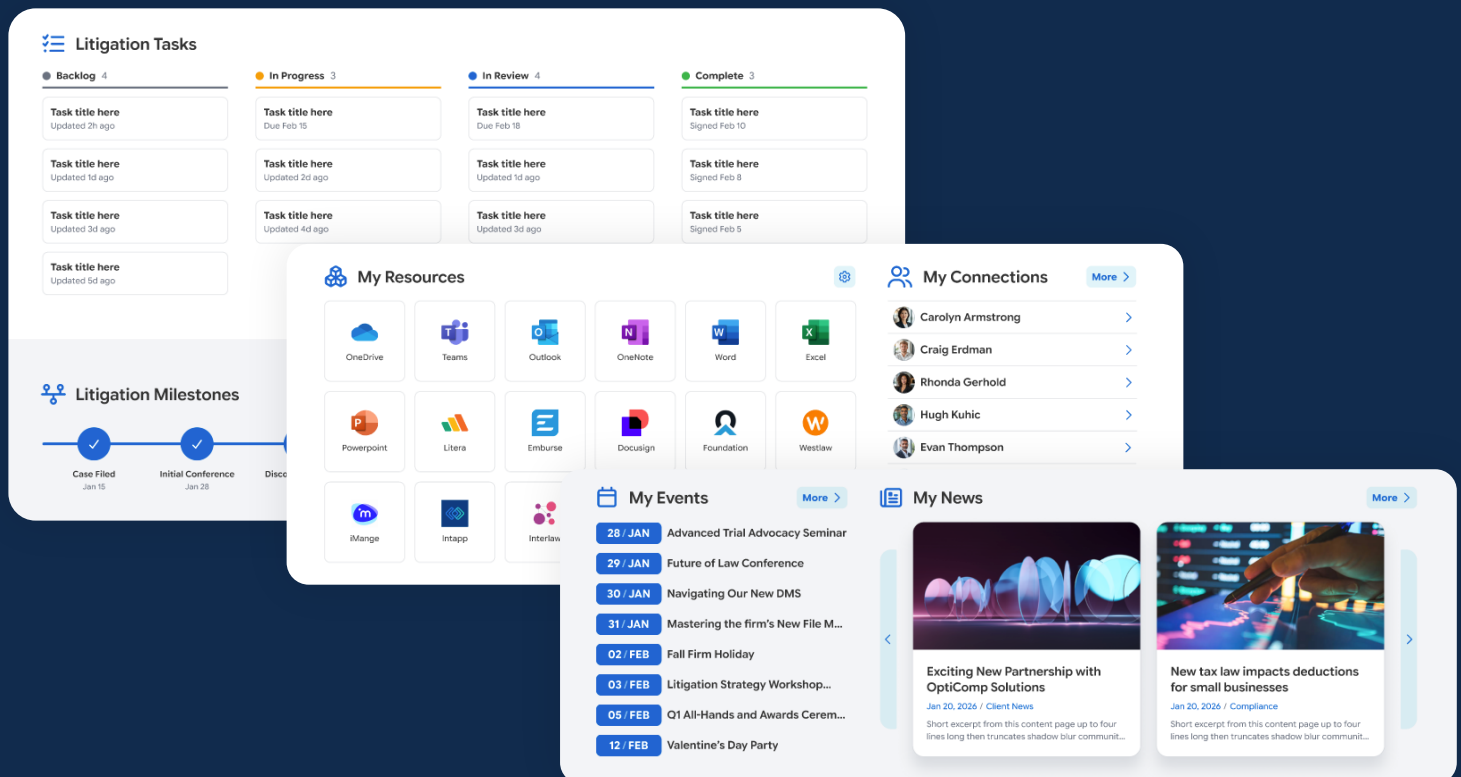

# From Intranets to Innovation

In this session, Adam Young, cofounder and COO of Infodash, takes a different approach from typical product showcases. Instead of walking through features and functionality, he traces Infodash's four year journey from a scrappy startup of four partners solving on-prem intranet migrations, to its current position as the "Legal Innovation Platform" for law firms. Along the way, he shares how early architectural decisions, the rise of generative AI, and a willingness to evolve without chasing hype transformed what looked like a constraint, being inside the firm's four walls, into Infodash's biggest competitive differentiator.

- Constraints can become competitive advantages. While other AI products require firms to bring their data out to the AI, Infodash brings AI to where the firm's knowledge and systems already live.
- Stay focused, but stay aware. Infodash didn't chase the AI hype when ChatGPT launched in late 2022. Instead, the team kept executing on what was working while having serious internal conversations about the future. That discipline allowed them to evolve thoughtfully rather than pivot reactively.
- Infodash is no longer simply an intranet or extranet company. It has evolved into the "Legal Innovation Platform" for law firms - a platform that unifies knowledge and data from inside and outside the firm, enabling AI-driven search, workflows, and real work in one secure, security-trimmed environment.

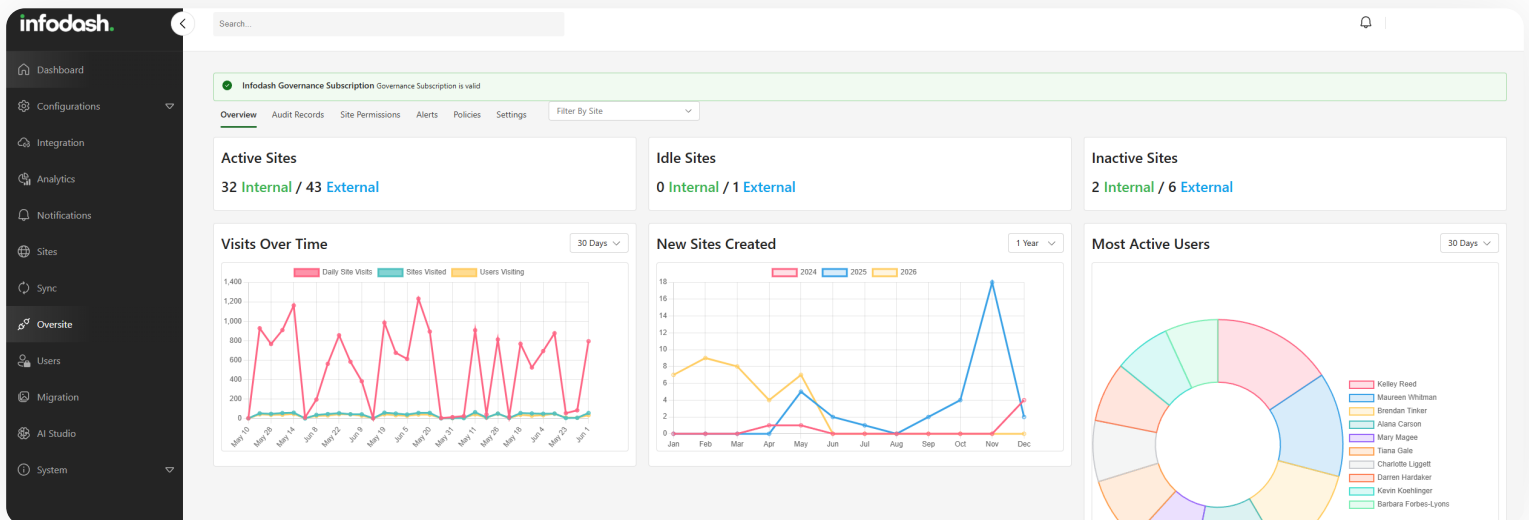
